The Horst family have used many types of feed storage, including bags, bunkers and tower silos. When having to buy feed after a plentiful harvest, because of mice holes in the bag, they made the decision to put up their first Harvestore. The family was so impressed by the quality of feed, that within six months they put up the second Harvestore. Brent Horst stated, "We see many benefits with our tower silos, including:

- ~ *The quality of feed is superior.*
- ~ *They take up less of a foot print /ground space.*
- ~ *Less dry matter loss - only 3 to 4% compared to 16 to 20% with a bunker.*
- ~ *Less man power to fill the tower silo. It is now a two man job.*
- ~ *Ability to store the feed when the crop is ready. We can chop a field one day, close the Harvestore and when another field is ready, we open it and fill again."*
