“After making the decision to start dairy farming, we built a new dairy barn. For two years we used ag bags for our feed storage, but in the summer of 2013 we put up a tower silo. There is definitely less waste and no feed spoilage now compared to the the issues we encountered because of rodents and other animals chewing and tearing holes in the bags. Plus, this time of year we no longer have to be out in the mud trying to load silage. It is also easier filling the tower silo versus the difficulty of trying to get the custom chopper and the renting of a bagger to come together at the same time.”
