



Silo Maintenance Checklist



- Clear away debris from around the silo base.
- Make sure all silo drains are open.
- Make sure drainage will not cause a pollution problem.
- Check the condition of the exterior wall for cracks, holes, seepage erosion, etc.
- Check the condition of the interior wall for softness, pitting, holes, etc.
- Check the condition of the door frames.
- Check for loose, corroded, or broken hoops (stave silos).
- Check for corroded tie rods or bars across the doorways.
- Check the condition of all silo doors and door related hardware.
- Check the condition of all ladders and ladder fasteners.
- Check the condition of the safety cage and ladder platforms.
- Make sure the fill pipe is straight, tight, and in good condition.
- Make sure the roof is sound, tight, and properly fastened.
- Check the silage spreader for wear, lubrication, and adjustment.
- Check the condition of the unloader lifting winch and cable.
- Check the condition of the silo chute.
